The Association of the Caginazzi [sp?] at the America Way, which is an organization that is based in my community that originally is rooted in Italy and they have done fantastic work organizing fundraising campaigns to award scholarships to high school seniors for college; they provide support to charitable organizations including the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation and direct support to many families that are in need in my community and this is

definitely a way to pay respect and homage to the great contributions of the Italian-American community in New York.

Also, another street renaming is after
Pastor Aquiles [sp?], who was affectionately called
the pastor of Coney Island; he was born in Mayaguez,
Puerto Rico; he obtained a bachelor's degree and two
doctorate degrees in divinity and the humanities. He
was really a major fixture in our community; his
church became a sanctuary to all of the Sandy
survivors and people in need, and we lost him, you
know really, a sad passing; he passed away due to
cancer and he's deeply missed and loved in the Coney
Island community.

I want to also note, finally, we're renaming a street in Coney Island after Rosea Weisch; [sp?] she was a pillar in the Coney Island community, born in North Carolina, graduated from Boston University; worked in Coney Island Hospital for a number of years. She started the first African-American senior club at the Surfside Gardens Community Center, which is a very inclusive organization; she was very active in houses of worship, and resident leader at Coney Island Houses

Robinson played for the Brooklyn Dodgers and advanced the cause of professional African-American athletes. In 1955, he helped the Dodgers reach the pinnacle of major league baseball by winning the World Series. He retired in 1957 with a career batting average of .311, and in 1962 he became the first African-American to be introduced into the Baseball Hall of In 1972, the Dodgers retired his name and his uniform 42. In 1964 -- I wanna tell you when I was born -- he helped establish the African-Americanowned Freedom Bank and he also served on the board of the NAACP until 1967. And I just want to thank my community for bringing this forward and I give really
