I am Rafael Salamanca, Jr. Chair 5 of the Subcommittee on Planning, Dispositions and 6 Concessions. Welcome to today's hearing. Todav we're 7 joined by Council Member Andy Cohen, Council Member 8 Darlene Mealy, Council Member Mark Treyger, and we 9 have Chair Greenfield here with us. Today we'll be 10 voting on Edwins Place Application, LU 792 through 11 795. These are applications by HPD for a zoning map 12 change from R6 to R7-2/C2-3, a zoning text amendment 13 to establish a Mandatory Inclusionary Housing are, a 14 zoning special permit to allow community facility 15 floor area to apply to non-profit supportive housing 16 and our Urban Development Action Area Project, UDAAP, 17 designation project approval. And disposition 18 approved for city-owned property of 3 Livonia Avenue 19 in Brooklyn. These actions would facilitate the 20 development of a new 8-story building with 125 21 supportive and affordable housing units, and ground 22 floor retail or community facility space. 23 project is in Council Member Mealy's district, and 24 with that, we're going to hand it over to Council 25 Member Mealy.

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2 COUNCIL MEMBER MEALY: Well, I just want to say thank you, Chair. Thank you my co-leader of 3 4 the Brooklyn Delegation for his hard work in advocating for this. I want to thank the Mayor for 5 the three centers and I could say thank you Breaking 6 7 Grounds for the community input that you will be 8 giving, and I just want to thank my colleagues. I want to thank David Greenfield for coaching (sic) this through, and making sure that the community is 10 11 whole. I wish it was much more affordability for 12 people who have jobs, but instead of giving nothing, 13 I'd rather give a whole lot back to my community, and 14 I want to Mayor-I want to thank Ms. Umay (sp?), Umay. 15 She helped from the Mayor's Office to make sure that this was a positive experience for myself and others. 16 17 So, with that, I will be voting yes, and Chair, don't 18 smile so much.
