My name is Brad Lander. I'm Chair of the Committee. We're re-opening the meeting from last week Wednesday, December 6th. We are joined by Council Members Debbie Rose, Margaret Chin, Dan Garodnick and Minority Leader Steven Matteo and Council Member Helen Rosenthal, and Mark Levine is close by. Okay. I am just 6 7 flagging for the record and for the members, too, if 8 they look in their books note that we have a good strong written waiver from the New York City Conflicts of Interest Board regarding Anne Holford-10 11 Smith's service PBDW Architects, which has a fair amount of business before the Landmarks Preservation 12 13 Commission, but she will both not work on or be 14 compensated for those projects on the firm's side, 15 and she will also not consider or be involved in any way in the consideration of those projects ono the 16 17 LPC side, and that firewall is essentially signed off 18 on by the Conflicts of Interests Board, and she 19 answered our questions very thoroughly about it at 20 the hearing. With those preliminaries out of the 21 way, are there any members who wish to say anything 2.2 or ask any questions about any of these candidates? 2.3 If not, we will move to vote on both of them.
