CHAIRPERSON MOYA: We're ready. Alright. Good morning, and welcome to the meeting of the Subcommittee on Zoning and Franchises. I am Council Member Francisco Moya, Chair of the Subcommittee, and today we are joined by Council Members Costa Constantinides, Antonio Reynoso, Donovan Richards, and Barry Grodenchik. Today, we have a very quick agenda. LU 60 and the application to operate an unenclosed sidewalk café at 1-50 50th Avenue in Council Member Van Bramer's district in Queens was withdrawn. So, we will not have a hearing on that item. So, today we will be voting to approve LUs 61 and 62, the NYPD's 116th Precinct Application. Approval for this application for site selection and acquisition of a police precinct station house, and zoning map change to map a C1-3 Commercial overlay in an existing R3-2 district will allow for the construction of a new long awaited 116th Police Precinct on the exiting parking lot that is accessory to the existing facility. The property is located at 242-20 North Conduit Avenue in Council Member Richard's district in Queens, and I know that Council

1 SUBCOMMITTEE ON ZONING AND FRANCHISES 5 this done. The current 105th Precinct encompasses 2 12.7 square miles with 354 miles of roadways 3 including seven major highways. This is more highway 4 miles than a trip to Boston or Washington, D.C. but 5 I'm happy to say today we are one step closer to 6 7 making the issue of a long-of long response times in the distant police precincts—the distant police 8 presence a thing of the past for the residents for 9 Laurelton, Rosedale and Springfield Gardens with the 10 new 116th Precinct. This has always been about 11 12 public safety and equity. Our community should not have to beg for this, and we just want the same 13 things every other neighborhood wants, to feel safe 14 15 in our homes, on our streets, and at our jobs. 16 Administration after administration have denied the pleas of our community, but thankful to Mayor de 17 18 Blasio and Commissioner O'Neill, we are finally delivering on a promise after 40 years that some 19 20 would not even entertain. The commitments for the new 116th Precinct includes \$7 million for the 21 construction of Safe City its self-contained 2.2 23 education and administrative facility designed to help school students learn about street and 24

pedestrian safety, and, of course, as we see

2	congestion in our city and our roadways in need of a
3	lot of paving, I'm happy to announce the
4	Administration has also committed \$1.4 million for
5	street repaving desperately needed for the area
6	surrounding the new precinct as well, and a minimum
7	of 800 square feet of dedicated community facility
8	space, and agreement to meet quarterly with the
9	Community Advisory—Advisory Committee throughout the
10	design and the construction phase of this project.
11	Not only is this a victory for all of Eastern Queens,
12	but it is a very special victory for the advocates
13	who have been calling for this for nearly four
14	decades. I want to shout out Besta Bentham of
15	Community Board 13 as well for putting this in the
16	budget concerns every year for the past 40 years, and
17	this is a major victory for them as well. I'd like
18	to thank Mayor de Blasio, Commissioner O'Neill and
19	once again Zoning Chair Francisco Moya, DOT
20	Commissioner—Queens Commissioner Nicole Garcia,
21	Phillip Heller, Nick Smith, and the Land Use
22	Committee team Raju, Amy and John and, of course, my
23	colleague who represents the little eastern-east for
24	me, Barry Grodenchik who really when we came in said
25	he wanted to prioritize this as well, and we worked

2	hand-in-hand on this. So, I'm very grateful to
3	everybody. I want to thank my staff member Debony
4	Brown who really worked day in and day out on some o
5	the negotiations to get this done and we're finally
6	here. This is a big victory for our community. It
7	shows that persistence overcomes resistance on any
8	day. So, thank you, Mr. Chair, and I urge everybody
9	to vote aye.

CHAIRPERSON MOYA: Congratulations again to you Council Member for your hard work. We know that you've been working on this for a long time, and this is going to be something very, very good for your community. So, congratulations on that. As I mentioned, early the sidewalk café has been withdrawn. So, we will also be voting on a motion to file LU 16 in Council Member Van Bramer's district. So, with that, I move for a vote to approve LUs 61, 62 and a motion to file LU 60. Counsel, please call the roll.
