AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to available transportation for correction facility visitation

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The correction law is amended by adding a new section 138-b 2 to read as follow:

 § 138-b. Visitor transportation. In conjunction with the inmate visit-

ing program, the department shall provide transportation for visitors to

- 5 correctional facilities on a regular basis, but no less than bimonthly, 6 at no cost to visitors. Transportation shall be provided from the city
- 7 of New York, Rochester, Syracuse and Albany to correctional facilities,
- 8 as determined by the commissioner. Information concerning transportation
