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half years in this community. There has been a task force that is comprised of community members, very diverse representation from East Harlem that has engaged in a dialogue and has shaped this development project. So it has been a project that has been shaped from the ground up and it is very much reflective of a lot of community dialogue and discussion. So I'm very proud of the community-based planning process, I'm very proud of the extensive dialogue that has resulted in a project that has community benefits that are far beyond, I think, the -- what we've seen in other developments and I'm very thankful for all the work that has been laid by previous colleagues in their negotiations, but I truly believe that this will be an asset to East Harlem on the front of job creation, of solid job creation that are going to be union jobs with benefits and a lot of them that's going to create affordable housing, that's going to create community space, that's going to really be something that is -- we can -- something a project that we can be proud of. So I really want to thank again the Land Use Committee and the subcommittees, my colleagues Dan Garodnick,
