5	district, 20095124HHK. It is Kings County T
6	Building HHC Lease. The second is in Councilwoman
7	Sears' district, construction of intermediate
8	school, a 390-seat school. We don't have the
9	location; 20085366SCQ. LU number 862 is
10	Hopkinson/Park Place, Council Member Mealy's
11	district. It's a motion to file pursuant to
12	withdrawal by the agency. LU number 863 is a
13	ULURP and a UDAAP for section 202 housing for the
14	elderly; Council Member Mealy's district on St.
15	Marks Avenue. LU number 880 and 881 are related.
16	They are the St. George rezoning. It is an
17	amendment to the zoning map to foster the future
18	development of the St. George area. It is in
19	Council Member McMahon's district. It is an
20	amendment to the zoning map and an amendment to
21	the zoning text. LU number 884, West Chelsea
22	Historic District, Council Member Quinn's
23	district; it is the landmarking of this historic
24	area. LU number 892 is Morningside Park Scenic
25	Landmark, Council Member Dickens's office; it is

2	on 123rd Street and Amsterdam Avenue to				
3	Morningside Drive. LU number 904, West 22nd				
4	Street Garage in Speaker Quinn's district; it's a				
5	special permit for an unattended public parking				
6	garage. LU number 905 is TriBeCa North text				
7	amendment, is in Council Member Gerson's District				
8	and it's an amendment to the TriBeCa North mixed				
9	use district. LU number 911 is a sidewalk café in				
10	Council Member Avella's district. That will be a				
11	motion to deny; so a yes vote is a motion to deny.				
12	LU number 912 is in Council Member Vollone's				
13	district. It is a sidewalk café called Cherry				
14	Café Restaurant. Any discussion from Committee				
15	Members first? Council Member Eugene would like				
16	to make a comment on his application in his				
17	district.				
18	COUNCIL MEMBER EUGENE: Thank you				

very much, Madam Chair. I just want to say that as we all know there is a shortage of nurses in the health area. And I think this has a negative impact on the quality of health that people may receive. And I think creating a nursing school is a very important, very, very important step for the community, for Brooklyn and for New York. And

2	I think that not only this is going to fill the
3	need, the very important need of nurses that we
4	have in the medical field, but that is going to
5	create also job opportunities. And I'm very, very
6	pleased to see that the Office of the Mayor pay
7	for some teaching also. And this is going to give
8	hope and job opportunity and that is going to
9	create also expert nurses that New York needs,
LO	that Brooklyn needs. And as a medical doctor, I
11	am strongly supporting this initiative. And I'm
L2	asking all my colleagues also to support this
L3	initiative and I want to commend and congratulate
L4	Long Island University, which is a very, very
15	important institution in New York; and I am so
L6	pleased so see this is going to happen in my
