3	to call this Committee hearing to order. Good			
4	morning, everyone. My name is Erik Martin Dilan			
5	and I am the Chairman of the City Council's			
6	Housing and Buildings Committee. Today the			
7	Committee will be hearing a pre-considered			
8	resolution sponsored by Council Member Mendez, who			
9	is the Chair on the Subcommittee of Public			
10	Housing. And the purpose of today's hearing is to			
11	vote on a resolution that calls on the United			
12	States Congress to pass, and the President of the			
13	United States to approve, a second economic			
14	stimulus package that includes a \$5 billion in			
15	supplemental funding for the Public Housing			
16	Capital Fund. Due to NYCHA's operating budget			
17	deficits since fiscal year 2002, the Authority has			
18	routinely transferred capital funds into their			
19	operating budget in order to close their budget			
20	gaps. And since fiscal year 2001, NYCHA has			
21	repeatedly been shortchanged every fiscal year by			
22	the tune of overall \$500 million in capital and			
23	operating expenses. Due to this practice of			
24	delaying capital projects into their operating			
25	budgets, many of their needed capital improvements

already identified \$500 million in capital

projects that would be ready to start immediately

should these funds become available. I urge my

COUNCIL MEMBER MENDEZ: Thank you, Chair Dilan, and my thanks to you and Speaker Quinn for assisting in getting this Reso done in such a quick time. The reason that we had to move forward with this quickly is because there's an opportunity to get Washington to vote on a second economic stimulus package. If approved it would be implemented during the tenure of President-Elect Obama and would infuse all public housing authorities with the necessary money for capital that all housing authorities across the nation have been shortchanged during the Bush years. York City Housing Authority alone was shortchanged \$502 million. Any money that would come from this stimulus package would get to address dire needed capital repairs, such as the elevators, which many
