CHAIRPERSON GARODNICK: Good

morning everyone and welcome to the Subcommittee
on Planning, Dispositions and Concessions. This
is the continuation of a recessed meeting of
December 15th. My name is Dan Garodnick. I have
the privilege of chairing the Subcommittee. I'm
joined by Committee Members Maria Baez, Sara
Gonzalez, Vinny Ignizio; also joined by members of
the Land Use Committee, Maria del Carmen Arroyo,
Tony Avella, Jessica Lappin and Simcha Felder. We
have one item on today's agenda. It is Land Use
number 898 to 903, the related items at Via Verde,
in the district of Council Member Maria del Carmen
Arroyo. There was some discussion about the
income targets on the subject of the rental and
cooperative units in this item. And I just want
to read for the record the provision within the
project summary that pertains to income targets as
has been worked out between HPD and the local
Council Member. The rental units will be rented
to households with annual incomes at or below 60%
AMI and 90% AMI. The cooperative units will be
sold at prices based on households earning 110%
AMI. However, if additional City subsidies are

made available to the project by the City Council 2 prior to the earlier of July 31, 2010 or the 3 4 commencement of marketing up to 20 of the 5 cooperative unites as determined by HPD based on the amount of additional available funds, must be 6 sold at prices based on households earning incomes in the range of 80% of AMI to 100% of AMI with the 9 exact breakdown among those tiers to be determined at that time. Provided further, if prior to the 10 11 marketing of units HPD determines in writing that 12 market conditions make it feasible for a sponsor 13 to sell a certain number of units as determined by 14 HPD, to purchasers with higher incomes than 110% 15 of AMI, then the subject of such other terms and 16 conditions imposed by HPD, a sponsor may market 17 and sell units to such purchasers at prices 18 approved by HPD within the parameters of the 19 requirements of other lenders and Article 11 of 20 the Private Housing Finance Law. So with that, 21 Council Member Arroyo has indicated her support of 22 this project and Land Use numbers 898 to 903. 23 want to recognize that we're joined by Committee 24 Member Inez Dickens of Manhattan. And with that 25 we move directly to a vote. Chair recommending an
