CHAIRPERSON DIAZ: One more time. [gavel] Good morning ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the hearing of the City Council For-Hire Vehicle Committee. I am Ruben Diaz, Senior, the Chair of the Committee. First, let me recognize my colleagues who are here today. Give me that number. Here we have Council Member Ydanis Rodriguez, Council Member Vallone, Council Member Borelli and Council Member Williams. Today, we will be voting on an important piece of legislation that will provide greater enforcement of commuter vans. Proposed Introduction No. 925-A sponsored by Council Member Jumaane Williams would clarify that the Taxi and Limousine Commission has enforcement authority over unlawfully operated commuter van with at seating capacity of greater than 20. Illegal and unlicensed behavior creates a risk to the public, and this legislation seeks-seeks to protect the public from unlawful behavior. I would like to invite Council Member Williams to deliver his position opening statement in regard to this bill.

2	COUNCIL MEMBER WILLIAMS: Thank you,
3	Chair and I want to thank you for helping make sure
4	this bill comes for a vote today. This is about
5	commuter vans also know as dollar vans. I'm a big
6	supporter of that industry, and I'm thankful this
7	Council has done more than any other to make sure
8	that they have a place to operate within the
9	transportation system of the city of New York. We
10	also want to make sure we're doing that while making
11	sure the public is protected as reasonably as
12	possible. There is a loophole that did not allow the
13	TLC to enforce all the laws with vans over 20. That,
14	of course, does not provide the best safety for our
15	public. That is whether or not they had a license,
16	whether or not they had insurance. The TLC simply
17	could not do anything about it, and this is basically
18	an enforcement bill to provide a safe space for the
19	public while supporting the van industry. I want to
20	thank you again, Mr. Chair, the Speaker and everyone
21	who is co-cosigned on it. Particularly, I want to
22	thank Daneek Miller for working with me to make sure
23	that this got to this space, and I'm looking forward
24	to working with him on another bill that I know will
25	be coming shortly. Thank you

Williams for such a wonderful piece of legislation, and I would appreciate and thank all the members, the members of the committee that are present today showing their concern and their responsibility to this committee, and the position of their—that they are—that they are. Now, I will call for a vote on Proposed Introduction 925-A. I as the Chairman of the Committee recommend a yes vote and I ask the Committee Clerk to please call the roll.
