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CHAIRPERSON AVELLA:

I'd like to

call on the Subcommittee on Zoning and Franchises to order. If everybody else would take their conversations outside the room, please, it would be extremely helpful. [pause] At our last meeting of the subcommittee, we heard the public hearing--[gavel] I'm not going to say it again, please. There's enough committee meetings that are already backed up, so if I could ask for everybody's cooperation. At the last meeting, we had the public hearing on the Sidewalk Bar and Restaurant, in Council Member Rosie Mendez's district, and we held off on the vote so that agreement could be reached between the community Council Member and the applicant. The applicant is here, I'd like to call them up to read into the record what the new agreement is. Press the button.

STEVE WYGOTE: Hello. My name is

Steve Wygote [phonetic], I'm the architect

representing the two owners who are to my left.

We want to thank the council member for her work,

working with us, and we appreciate the effort

that's been made here. We came to an agreement as

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2	from the edge of the curb to the railing. Next
3	item is that the two owners have given their
4	personal cell numbers as well as one of the
5	owner's daughter, who lives in the building, we've
6	given that to the City Council, so that they can
7	contact us, them immediately, in case of an issue.
8	Next item, there is a pole, a traffic pole, that
9	bicycles are being hooked up to; not their
10	bicycles, other people's bicycles. The, or my
11	client has asked me to file for a revocable permit
12	for a bike rack on Avenue A, and we will do every,
13	make every effort not to have bicycles chained up
14	to that one traffic pole. And we are aware that
15	we, that the City will come out and do intimate
16	inspections at their discretion, and we will, the
17	appthe owners agree to all these requirements.
18	CHAIRPERSON AVELLA: And the
19	Department of Consumer Affairs will be asked to do
20	a qualifying inspection based upon the new
21	application.
22	STEVE WYGOTE: We understand that
23	as well, thank you.

CHAIRPERSON AVELLA: And just for

clarification about the bike rack, the owner is
