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2 COUNCIL MEMBER VALLONE: Welcome

everyone. I'm Council Member Vallone, I'm chairing today's hearing for Council Member Jim Gennaro. We're holding hearings today and voting on Intro 622A, which deals with retrofitting and retirements of diesel fuel powered school buses used bye special education students. Our children are the most precious resource and one of the most important jobs that the Department of Education performs is transporting our children safely to and from school. But currently air pollution from school buses presents a threat to the health of some of our children who ride school buses. Children are more susceptible to air pollution than adults because they take in more air per unit of body weight than adults. And children spend more time outdoors than adults.

As children, they are least able to mitigate the impacts of air pollution. Studies of pollutant exposures show higher levels of exposure inside of school buses from fugitive diesel exhaust that travels through cracks in the chastity and finds its way into the school bus cabin. By using trace gas experiments that

measure air quality in empty school buses and on routes, researchers were able to establish that children riding in school buses inhale at least seven times more exhaust than non-riding residents inhale from all school bus emissions in the study area.

New York City acted to address school bus self pollution in general education buses by enacting local law 42 of 2005 that required that diesel fuel powered school buses be retrofitted but excluded buses used for special education needs. So local law 42 covers 2,322 of DOE's 6,770 public diesel school buses.

Today's legislation is designed to close that loophole. Proposed Intro 622A requires that 100% of diesel fueled powered school buses used to fulfill each school bus contract be equipped with such closed crank case ventilation systems by September 1, 2011. And further prohibits diesel fuel powered school buses from being used to fulfill any school bus contract beyond the end of the 16th year from the date of manufacture, thereby, getting rid of the oldest and most polluting school buses.

2	I commend all who were involved in
3	the passage of this legislation, especially those
4	sitting out here in front and staff. I hope that
5	we continue to work with the administration to
6	address any additional costs, if they occur. I'm
7	sure that will happen. I look forward to having a
8	vote on this and being a sponsor of this important
9	legislation.
