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3 CHAIRPERSON MOYA: Good morning and 4 welcome to the meeting of the Subcommittee on Zoning 5 and Franchises. I am Council Member Francisco Moya, 6 the Chairperson of the Subcommittee, and we are 7 joined here today by Council Members Rivera, Reynoso, 8 Levin, Richards, Grodenchik. If-we also if there is 9 anyone here to testify please fill out a speaker slip 10 with the sergeant-at-arms indicating your full name, 11 and the application name or LU number. Today, we 12 will hear LU 463 an application by the New York City 13 Housing, Preservation and Development for the 14 disposition of city-owned property Lot 3 on Block 15 2360 pursuant to the Private Housing Finance Law in connection with the Brook 156 rezoning in Chair 16 17 Salamanca's district in the Bronx. I now open the 18 public hearing on this application, and I will call 19 up Artie Pearson. [pause] And Counsel, if you could 20 please swear in the panel.

LEGAL COUNSEL: Please state your name for—as part of your response. Do you swear or affirm that the testimony you're about to give will be the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth, and you'll answer questions truthfully?

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2	ARTIE PEARSON: Yes.
3	CHAIRPERSON MOYA: You may begin.
4	ARTIE PEARSON: I'm Artie Pearson from
5	HPD's Office of Intergovernmental Affairs. Land Use
6	No. 463 pertains to the disposition approval of a
7	city-owned lot located at Block 2360, Lot 3 in the
8	now row (sic) section of the Bronx in Council
9	District 17. This land use item is related to other
10	land use items that were previously approved by the
11	Subcommittee. Brook 156 will be developed by the
12	sponsor of Fitz (sic) Houses who proposes to
13	construct a residential building under HPD's
14	extremely low-
15	CHAIRPERSON MOYA: [interposing] I'm
16	sorry-could you just move the microphone a little
17	closer? Than you.
18	ARTIE PEARSON: Under HPD's extremely and
19	low-income program also know as ELLA. Under the ELLA
20	program sponsors develop multi-family buildings in
21	order to create low-income rental housing for
22	families with a range of incomes from 30% to 60% of
23	the area median income, and projects may include tier
24	of units with rents targeted to households earning up
25	to 100% of the AMI. Subject to project underwriting

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2	up to 30% of the units may be rented to formerly
3	homeless households referred by the Department of
4	Homeless Housing or other public agencies. The
5	project consists of the city-owned lots, and adjacent
6	privately owns lots, which is Lot 1. Lot 1 is the
7	former rail—the former rail rights-of-way, our
8	inactive open cut railroad trench. Both lots were
9	designated as part of the Urban Renewal site 404
10	under the Mott Haven North Urban Renewal Plan in
11	1994. It should be noted that while Mott Haven Urban
12	Renewal Plan with not expire until 2034, the land use
13	restrictions on Site 404 did expire in 2008. Thank
14	you.
15	CHAIRPERSON MOYA: Thank you very much
16	for your testimony today. Thank you. [pause] Are
17	there any other members of the public who wish to
18	testify? Seeing none, I now close the public hearing
19	and move to our votes. We will now vote to approve
20	LU 463, the application that was heard today by the
21	Subcommittee submitted by HPD for the disposition of
22	city-owned property related the Brook 156 rezoning in
23	Committee Chair Salamanca's district in the Bronx.
24	Chairman Salamanca is in support of this application.
25	We will also vote to approve LU 438 an application by
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2	Center Boulevard Restaurant LLC, American for a
3	revocable consent to maintain, operate and use an
4	unenclosed sidewalk café at 201 50 th Avenue in
5	Council Member—in Council Member Van Bramer's
6	district in Queens. We will be voting to approve
7	this café the size of which has been adjusted in
8	response to community concerns from 24 tables and 86
9	seats to 12 tables and 48 seats. Council Member Van
10	Bramer has stated his support for this application
11	based on the applicant's written points of agreement
12	noted in the record. Today, we will also vote to
13	approve LU 419 for the Court Square Block 3 Text
14	Amendment in Queens. The proposal would modify
15	height and setback regulations applicable to Block 3
16	in Court Square Sub-district of the Special Long
17	Island City District to facilitate the development of
18	a new approximately 45-story mixed use building.
19	Council MemberCouncil Member Van Bramer is in
20	support of this application. I now call for a vote
21	to approve LUs 419, 438 and 463. Counsel, please
22	call the roll.
23	LEGAL COUNSEL: Chair Moya.
24	CHAIRPERSON MOYA: Aye on all.
25	LEGAL COUNSEL: Council Member Rivera.

The vote is 6 in 18 the affirmative 0 in the negative and no abstentions. The items are approved and referred to the Land Use 19 20 Committee. CHAIRPERSON MOYA: This concludes today's 21 meeting.
