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ISRAEL MARTINEZ: Sound check for the Committee on Land Use, being recorded by Israel Martinez August 14, 2019, taking place in City Council Chambers.

SERGEANT AT ARMS: Quiet, please.

CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: [gavel] All right, good morning everyone and welcome to the Columbia. am Council Member Rafael Salamanca. I am the chair of this committee. I would like to welcome my esteemed colleagues who are members of the committee that are present today. We have Council Members Deutsch, Koo, Lancman, Levin, Reynoso, Richards, Treyger, Grodenchik, Chair Adams, Diaz, Chair Moya, and I would like to thank Chair Moya and Chair Adams for their work on our land use subcommittees. Today we will be voting on projects referred out of both of our subcommittees. We will vote to approve LUs 500, an application by Madre Hospitality Inc., D/B/A Franklin Guest House, for a revocable consent to maintain, operate, and use an unenclosed sidewalk cafe at 214 Franklin Street in Council Member Levin's district in Brooklyn. We will also vote to approve with modifications preconsidered LUs 479 and 480, the 273 Avenue U rezoning for property in Council Member

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Treyger's district in Brooklyn. The applicant seeks approval of a zoning map amendment and related zoning text amendment, to rezone the project area from R5B to an R6A district and establish a mandatory inclusionary housing area utilizing MIH option 2. These actions would facilitate the development of a new four-story mixed use building with ground floor residential use and approximately nine dwelling units. Our modifications will be to remove MIH option 2 and to add MIH option 1. We will be voting to approve preconsidered LU 20185509, SEQ, submitted by the New York City School Construction Authority for the site selection of a new, approximately 306seat pre-K center. The site is located within a portion of Flushing Meadow Corona Park and adjacent to the New York Hall of Science in Community School District 21 in Chair Moya's district in Queens. will also vote to approve preconsidered LU C190286AHAK, the East New York North H NCP UDAAP application. The application filed by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development is for designation of an urban development action area and an urban development action area project, as well as for the disposition of properties located in 190

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Essex Street, 227 Vermont Street, 225 Vermont Street, 223 Vermont Street, 582 Belmont Avenue, and 581 Belmont Avenue. Approvals will facilitate the development of a three-story building, providing 41 units of affordable housing on these projects in Council Member Espinal's district in Brooklyn. will also vote to approve the LUs 477 and 478, the 201-207 Seventh Avenue Project. The application filed by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development is for designation of an urban development action area and an urban development action area project, as well for the disposition of property located at 201-207 Seventh Avenue in the speaker's district in Manhattan. In addition, a tax exemption pursuant to Article 11 of the Private Housing Finance Law is sought. Approval will facilitate the development of a new nine-story mixed use building with 26 affordable cooperative home ownership units as well as retail space. I will now call for a vote in accordance with the recommendations of the subcommittees to approve LUs 477, 478, 500, and preconsidered LUs 20185509SEQ and C190286AHAK and to

2 COUNCIL MEMBER TREYGER: Thank you, 3 While I had many initial concerns with the Chair. application related to 273 Avenue U, including the 4 fact that the applicant's proposed development falls 5 below the unit in area threshold for MIH 6 7 applicability, through considerable dialogue with the applicant, a long-standing family from the 8 neighborhood, I have obtained several written 9 commitments which have mitigated my concerns. 10 applicant has pledged to voluntarily below-market 11 12 rental rates for both existing commercial tenants and prospective residential tenants, to ensure that 13 14 general and subcontractors are M/WBEs, to develop a 15 local hiring plan in conjunction with the Coney 16 Island Work Force One center, to pay building service 17 workers fair wages with benefits, and to provide 18 streetscape and street safety improvements. Per Community Board 11's request the applicant has 19 20 committed to keeping the building to four stories, which will improve the existing streetscape, which is 21 2.2 incongruous because of a non-zoning compliant 23 building. Crucially, the applicant provided a letter of understanding between themselves and the operators 24 of Joe's of Avenue U, an iconic Sicilian restaurant 25

in Gravesend, which has, I think, the best rice bowls
in New York City, to maintain the restaurant at its
current location during construction to the greatest
extent feasible, and to maintain the local location
following construction. Colleagues, I respectfully,
I urge you to vote to approve the items Land Use 479
and 48. I would like to thank Chair Salamanca and
Chair Moya, Rosa Kelly, and Arthur Herr from the land
use staff, and Ana Scafe, my chief of staff as well.
Thank you very much. I vote aye.

behalf and on behalf of the parents in School		
District 24, the first time that we will have a stem		
pre-K to third grade coming to the district and		
couldn't be prouder to be supporting this. Thank		
you, Chair, for allowing us to explain my vote.
