Upon completion, the buildings will be three stories with a total of 22 one-bedroom units and 19 two-bedroom units, with 1 two-bedroom unit for the superintendent.

The target incomes for this project will be up to 70% of the Area Median Income (AMI), and with rents affordable to families with incomes between 27% and 67% AMI. The buildings will be built to meet Enterprise Green Community Standards. Additionally, building amenities will include a laundry room, enclosed bike parking, and a recreational rear yard in all three proposed buildings. In order to facilitate the development of the East New York North NCP project, HPD is before the Landmarks subcommittee seeking approval of this land use item.




Development Site 1: 190 Essex Street (Block 3956/Lot 59)








223-227 Vermont Street (Block 3706/Lots 12, 13, 14)




223-227 Vermont Street Site Plan



223-227 Vermont Street Ground Floor Plan




Development Site 3: 581-583 Belmont Avenue (Block 4012/Lots 32, 34)




581-583 Belmont Avenue (Block 4012/Lots 32, 34)



The site contains a total of approximately 43,516 square feet of lot area located along 111th Street between 45th and 46th Avenues. The land on which the proposed Pre-K Center is to be located has been approved by the New York State Legislature for use as a Pre-Center.
