Before we proceed into executive session, I will note for the public that the Committee may vote on certain items of business during the session and as a result there may be additional open session of the Committee later today. CHAIRMAN MATTEO: [gavel] Okay, good morning again. Thank you for your patience. Again, I'm Steve Matteo, chair of the Committee on Standards and Ethics joined by Karen Koslowitz and Margaret Chin and Serena Longley, our committee counsel. Committee is now returning to open session to make public the outcome of today's votes. As laid out in our public statement of August 21, after a wide range investigation conducted by both the Council's Office of the General Counsel and the special counsel retained by the Committee to prosecute this disciplinary proceeding, the Committee voted to issue four charges against Council Member King. charges are related to alleged retaliation, disorderly conduct, conflict of interest violations

and harassment. Since this Committee's last meeting which took place on August 21, it has come to attention that Council Member King has engaged in additional retaliatory behavior against staff members and additional conflict of interest violations. learning of this retaliatory conduct as well as apparent additional conflicts of interest violations, the Office of the General Counsel in conjunction with the special counsel immediately investigated and uncovered corroborating evidence. Based upon this evidence, this Committee has voted today to issue additional and superseding charges relating to this retaliatory behavior. Pursuant to the rules of the Council, this Committee will now hold a disciplinary hearing on the charges issued on August 21 as well as these superseding charges. At this time, the disciplinary hearing is scheduled to begin on September 13 at 10 a.m. Please note, however, that the date and time of the proceeding may be rescheduled at the discretion of the Chair of the Committee. The hearing will be held in executive session and Council Member King has a right to be represented by counsel at the hearing. The Council has hired Cary Cohen to serve as special counsel and

In addition to these superseding charges against Council Member King, the Committee voted today on a pending matter pertaining to Council Member Barry Grodenchik. On February 12, 2019, this Committee voted to open a matter into allegations that Council Member Grodenchik had violated the Council's policy against harassment and discrimination. After a full investigation and substantiation of these allegations, this Committee negotiated a settlement agreement with Council Member Grodenchik. This agreement, as well as a related public statement by the Council Member before the Committee, took place on May 14, 2019. Now this Committee has been informed that the Council Member has successfully completed the remaining term of his settlement agreement, a specialized multi-session training on preventing sexual harassment. training was personally paid for by the Council Member. Based upon this development, the Committee

5	close his pending matter. This concludes our summary
