Today, 20 the Rules Committee will consider two items. 21 first item is the appointment of Alana Sivin, Counsel 22 toe the City Council's Committee on Criminal Justice 23 for the appointment by the Council to the New York 24 City Board of Corrections Transgender, Gender Non-25 Conforming, Non-binary and Intersex Task Force, and

COMMITTEE ON RULES, PRIVILEGES AND ELECTIONS second we have a proposed change to the rules of the Council concerning a name change to a Land Use Subcommittee. If the Council appoints Ms. Sivin to the Transgender, Gender Non-Conforming, Non-binary and Intersex Task Force, she will serve for an undefined term. If the Council votes to approve the proposed Council rule change, Rule No. 11.10, the Subcommittee on Landmarks, Public Sitings and Maritime Uses will be changed to the Subcommittee on Landmarks, Public Sitings and Dispositions. A little bit about the Transgender, Gender Non-Conforming, Non-binary and Intersex Task Force. Pursuant to Local Law 145 of 2019, the Board of Corrections shall convene a task force to review the Department of Correction's policies as it relates to the treatment and the housing of transgender, gender nonconforming, non-binary and intersex individuals in the Department of Correction's custody. This task force shall consist of a representative from each of the following who shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing agency. The Department of Correction, Correctional Health Services, the Commission on Human Rights, the Mayor's Office to end Domestic and gender-based violence, the New York City Unity

The task force shall also include at least one representative from each of the following categories to be appointed by the Board of Corrections. Formerly incarcerated individuals, individuals formerly or currently incarcerated in the Transgender Housing Unit to the extent practicable, service providers that address transgender, gender non-conforming, non-binary and intersex individuals in custody as well as local and national organizations that address issues that are related to transgender, gender-non-conforming, non-binary and intersex individuals. Member of this task force shall serve without compensation and shall meet no less often than on a quarterly basis. Ms. Sivin is present here in our Chambers. If any of my colleagues have any questions. Our second item on the agenda is the Rules of the Council No. 11.10. The Land Use Committee has the following subcommittees: and Franchises, Landmarks, Public Sitings and Maritime Uses, and such others as shall be determined by the Speaker. The proposed change to Rule No. 11.10 will change the name of the Subcommittee on Landmarks, Public Sitings and Maritime Uses to the
