CHAIRPERSON DROMM: Alright. [gavel] Okay, Good morning and welcome to today's Finance Committee meeting. My name is Council Member Daniel Dromm, and I'm Chair of the committee. We have been joined by Council Members Mark Gjonaj, Council Member Jimmy Van Bramer, Council Member Robert Cornegy, Council Member Keith Powers, Council Member Barry Grodenchik and Council Member and Minority Leader Steve Matteo, and Council Member Helen Rosenthal sitting right next to Today the committee will be voting on three me. items, two Article XI property tax exemptions, and one big resolution. First we have the land use items. The first is Crown Plaza Apartments in Majority Leader Cumbo's district in Brooklyn. action would provide a partial 40-year Article XI property exemption to support the preservation of 76 units of affordable rental housing. Majority Leader Cumbo is supportive of this exemption. The second is 2178 Atlantic Avenue in Council Member Ampry's Samuel's district. This action would provide a partial 40-year Article XI property tax exemption to support the preservation of 16 units of affordable rental housing. Council Member Ampry Samuel is

2	supportive of this exemption. Finally, we have the
3	BID item. We are voting on a resolution setting forth
4	October 30, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. in this room to hold a
5	public hearing considering the local law that would
6	authorize an increase in the budgets of six existing
7	BIDs throughout the city to increase the amounts they
8	may expend annually. The budget increases have been
9	requested by the property owners within the
. 0	boundaries of each BID, and would be used to enhance
.1	the services provided. The six BIDs that are seeking
.2	budget increases are the 34 th Street BID in Speaker
.3	Johnson and Council Member Powers' districts. The
. 4	Fifth Avenue BID in Council Member Powers' district;
.5	the Fulton Mall BID in Council Member Levin's
. 6	district; the Metro Tech BID in Majority Leader Cumbo
.7	and Council Member Levin's districts; the NOHO BID ir
. 8	Council Member Chin and Rivera's districts; and the
. 9	Union Square in Council Member Rivera's district.
20	Each of these Council Members has indicated that they
21	support the requested budget increases. For more
22	information regarding the specific amounts of the
23	assessment increases and the reason for the request
24	can be found in the Committee reports prepared by the
25	Finance Division staff. Those are all of today's
