Proposed Actions: Zoning text amendment to update certain provisions of the Zoning Resolution related to POPS to achieve the following:


- Facilitate the updating of the existing public space symbol;



- Goal: For POPS to be easily identifiable as open to the public by providing clear, visible, and legible signage
- **Purpose of the rule:** To provide POPS owners with clear instructions on complying with the rule:
 - Signage specifications
 - DCP review process
 - Timeframe to submit signage plans to DCP and install signs by
