Good morning everyone. My name is Steven Matteo I am Chair of the Standards and Ethics

Committee. I am joined today by my colleagues

Margaret Chin and Karen Koslowitz. The Committee on

Standards and Ethics is meeting today pursuant to

section 10.80 of the Council Rules and to address

additional and unrelated Committee Business because

it is necessary for the Committee to discuss

confidential personnel issues, I am making a motion

for the Committee to move into Executive Session

pursuant to Article 7 of the Public Office Law. Do I

have a second?

KAREN KOSLOWITZ: Second.

STEVEN MATTEO, CHAIRPERSON: A motion has been made and seconded by Karen Koslowitz that the Committee move into Executive Session. All of those in favor of said motion, say aye?

ALL: Aye.

2	STEVEN MATTEO, CHAIRPERSON: Noting that
3	the ayes have it I am not going to close this portion
4	of the meeting and reopen it in Executive Session.
5	Before we proceed into Executive Session, I will note
6	for the public that the Committee may vote on certain
7	items of business during this session and as a result
8	there may be an additional open session of the
9	committee later today. Thank you. (gavel
10	pounding). Alright everyone, thank you for your
11	patience. We are back. Again, I am Steven Matteo, I
12	am Chair of the Committee on Standards and Ethics.
13	am joined by my colleagues, Vanessa Gibson, Karen
14	Koslowitz, Margaret Chin, Stephen Levin and his
15	adorable little daughter. Uhm, also Ben Smith our
16	Committee Counsel and Jim Carras our General Counsel.
17	The Committee on Standards and Ethics opened a
18	meeting earlier today pursuant to section 10.80 of
19	the Council Rules concerning allegations of potential
20	Council Member misconduct. We also met to discuss
21	additional and unrelated committee business. Because
22	it was necessary for the committee to discuss
23	confidential personnel issues in conjunction with a
24	pending disciplinary matter, the Committee voted to
25	move into Executive Session pursuant to article 7 of

2	Public Offices Law. We are now returning to open
3	session to make public the outcome of today's votes.
4	During today's closed session meeting, the Committee
5	received information from the Counsel's Office of the
6	General Counsel regarding potential violations of
7	Council Rules and City Law by a Council Member. The
8	Counsel's Office of the General Counsel has
9	undertaken preliminary inquiries into these potential
10	violations and based upon these inquiries this
11	Committee voted today to open a new matter and
12	authorize a full investigation into the matter. As
13	with all newly opened matters, the subject Council
14	Members identity will not be revealed at this time
15	and their identity will only be made public if the
16	potential violations are found to be substantiated
17	and charges are issued by this Committee. Finally,
18	last year this Committee voted to open a matter
19	pursuant to Council Rule 10.80, in the intervening
20	period the Counsel took institutional action to
21	address this reported conduct by a Council Member.
22	Upon review, the Committee is satisfied with the
23	sufficiency of the action by the Counsel and voted
24	today to close this matter. This concludes our
