CHAIRPERSON MATTEO: Good morning,
everyone. I'm Steve Matteo. I'm Chair of the
Standards and Ethics Committee. I've been joined by
my colleagues Karen Koslowitz and Margaret Chin. The
Committee on Standards and Ethics is meeting today
regarding a pending disciplinary matter opened on
January 15, 2020 pursuant to Section 10.80 of the
Council Rules. Because it is necessary for the
Committee to discuss confidential personnel issues I
am making a motion for the Committee to move into
Executive Session pursuant to Article 7 of the Public
Officers Law. Do I have a second?

COUNCIL MEMBER KOSLOWITZ: I second.

COUNCIL MEMBER CHIN: I second

5 everyone. Thank you and thank you for your patience.

6 Again, I'm Steven Matteo. I'm Chair of the Committee

7 on Standards and Ethics. I'm joined by Steve Levin,

8 and Karen Koslowitz. Margaret Chin was with us this

9 morning in Public Session and also in Executive

10 Session. I'm also-we are also joined by our General

12 Ben Smith. The Committee on Standards and Ethics

13 ppened a meeting earlier today regarding a pending

14 disciplinary matter initiated pursuant to Section

15 | 10.80 of the Council Rules. Because it was necessary

16 for the committee to discuss confidential personnel

17 | issues in conjunction with the pending disciplinary

18 | matter, the Committee voted to move into Executive

19 | Session pursuant to Article 7 of the Public Officers

20 | Law. We are now returning to open session to make

21 | public the outcome of today's vote regarding the

22 pending disciplinary matter. Based upon a wide

| ranging investigation conducted by both the Council's

24 Office of the General Counsel, and the Special

Counsel retained by the committee to investigate and

prosecute this disciplinary proceeding the Committee 2 3 voted today to issue multiple charges against Council 4 Member King. In sum, the charges allege that between 2017 and up until just two days ago, Council Member King engaged in conduct that violated multiple 6 7 provisions of Council Resolution Number 1138 of 2019, 8 violated certain laws of the City of New York, the rules and policy of the Council as well as possible certain laws of the State of New York. 10 11 specifically, the charges we voted to issue against 12 Council Member King are as follows: Disorderly 13 conduct, conflicts of interest violations, violations 14 of Council Resolution Number 1138 of 2019, and 15 violations of the Council's Anti-Discrimination and 16 Harassment Policy, which allegedly occurred in 2017. As you all know, on October 28, 2019, the Council 17 18 unanimously, except for Council Member King, voted to 19 issue the most sweeping and serious sanctions ever 20 posed against a Council Member. Among those 21 sanctions was the placement of a monitor in Council Member King's office to protect his staff against the 2.2 2.3 sort of egregious behavior laid out in the Committee's Report supporting the resolution and to 24 ensure that the Council's Rules and policies were

adhered to by Council Member King. Since Council 2 3 Member King's return from the one-month suspension imposed on him by the Council, it is alleged that he 4 5 repeated worked to circumvent the monitor, and he has violated the large majority of the provisions of the 6 7 resolution. Additionally, and since the issuance of 8 our report, both our Committee Counsel and the Special Counsel were approached by additional witnesses with new information regarding alleged past 10 11 misconduct by Council Member King. Among this 12 misconduct was a completely unacceptable-unacceptable violation of the Council's Anti-Harassment and 13 Discrimination Policy. Finally, and again, we cannot 14 15 at this time provide great detail, but there are also 16 allegations of misappropriation by Council Member 17 King of public funds for his own personal benefit. 18 We, of course, take such violations of the public 19 trust incredibly seriously, and are also issuing 20 charges specific to his apparent misconduct. I must 21 stress how deeply and profoundly troubled this 2.2 committee is by the allegations set forth in the 2.3 While we do not issuance of these charges charges. lightly especially so soon after the prior charges 24

and resulting resolution we must also must—we must
