7	Community Board 6, Council Member Dan Garodnick's
8	area. I'll wait for everybody to quiet down.
9	It's a school siting, Preconsidered LU 20105219SCM
10	for P.S./I.S. 281-M.
11	The next item is in Council Member
12	Mealy's district, Brooklyn Community Board 3.
13	It's an amendment to a previously approved UDAAP.
14	It's amendment 20105220HAK and it's an amendment
15	for 924 and 928 Madison Street and 1023, 1013,
16	1007, 1052 and 1054 Putnam Avenue, Borough of
17	Brooklyn.
18	The next item is LU 1271. It's
19	another amendment to a previously approved UDAAP
20	in Council Member Gennaro and Council Member
21	White's district, Community Board 12. It's Land
22	Use item 2010529HAQ, Affordable Housing
23	Development Corporation.
24	The item is a citywide item Land
25	Use 1282. It's a citywide item authorizing

We have three other items in

item 20105215PPK. It's in Brooklyn Community

Boards 5 and 6. It's a swap of exchange for a
city-owned parcel and a state-owned parcel with
Baltic and Forbell Streets. 250 Baltic Street
swapping with 338 Forbell Street in Council
Districts 20 and 27

We have a UDAAP in Council Member Mealy's district, Community Board 16, Hopkinson and Park Place, item C100067HAK.

The last item is a landmark in Council Member Avella's district, Land Use 1292. It's in Queens Community Board 7 and it's item 20105203HQK.

All of these items have been discussed and voted in the affirmative in the subcommittee meetings. I would recommend an affirmative vote on all these items. I'd like to combine all of the items for one vote. At this time, unless there are any questions from any of the members we can proceed to a vote. Council Member Garodnick?

COUNCIL MEMBER GARODNICK: Thank

you, Mr. Chairman, I'll be very brief. I just

wanted to express my support of Preconsidered Land

Use, the one involving P.S./I.S. 281-M, that's

20105219SCM. It is a siting of a school on 35th
Street and First Avenue. This is a siting which
is appropriate for the school. It was part of a
broader rezoning that we already did and passed in
the Council.

But the School Construction

Authority, in response to community concerns about the site and the plan has agreed to an extensive process for community consultation. We're grateful to that.

I want to thank Chair Lappin for her support and of course Council Member Mendez who shares the area and represents the district right across the street from this siting. So I want to encourage my colleagues to support that, particularly in light of the community consultation process that the School Construction Authority has engaged in.

And of course we do want the administration to be engaged on the broader issue of this site, the site plan, the fact that we now have a school which is moving forward faster than the development which was planned and we're going to need their help to find ways to address that

2	and mitigate any potential problems and find a way
3	to plan for this site in a way that works for all
4	interested parties here.

I also want to congratulate Council Member Gonzalez on the 197-a plan that is not only good for her community but she has personally worked on for years and years and years. So congratulations Council Member Gonzalez.

CHAIRPERSON COMRIE: Council Member Lappin followed by Council Member Gonzalez.

COUNCIL MEMBER LAPPIN: I just
wanted to congratulate Council Member Garodnick.
As we discussed a little bit yesterday at the
Education hearing, we have massive overcrowding in
District 2, particularly on the East Side of
Manhattan and have been discussing actively with
the Department of Education how we fix that. This
is a big piece of that puzzle.

When the Land Use Committee
approved the rezoning for the Con Ed solo site
this was a precondition for that. And even though
the site itself has stalled and the owner is
having some difficulty with his finances, it's
wonderful that the city is still moving forward

2	with the school because we desperately need those	
3	seats. So I want to thank Council Member	
4	Garodnick for his leadership on this and certainly	
5	urge my colleagues to vote in favor.	
6	COUNCIL MEMBER GONZALEZ: Thank you	
7	Chair. I'm going to take all the minutes from	
8	seven years that I've been here. I just want to	
9	let Council Member Charles Barron know that.	
10	COUNCIL MEMBER BARRON: Time, time,	
11	time.	
12	COUNCIL MEMBER GONZALEZ: The 197-a	
13	in Sunset Park is an incredible, incredible thing	
14	for us. I mean we've been working on it for many,	
15	many years when I was chair of that community	
16	board.	
17	I just want to congratulate	
18	Community Board 7 in Sunset Park for all their	
19	hard work, especially their chair Randy Peers.	
20	But more than anything, especially Joseph	
21	Longobardi, I wanted to go on record because he	
22	became Joe 197-a. I mean we hired consultants and	
23	paid them pennies actually to do the work that

they did and we've really come a long way.

2	to shepherd this through because I was part of
3	that vision and that vision has become a reality.
4	It's really significant for revitalization of the
5	waterfront. We signed on to the waterfront
6	principles in 2000 and today I urge all of my
7	colleagues to vote yes because it's been a lot of
8	hard work and it means job creation, recreation
9	and green for the waterfront which will mean a
10	future, Charles Barron. So I really, really need
11	your vote on this. Thank you my colleagues. Aye
12	on all.
