CHAIRPERSON DROMM: Just, what I think we will do is we will keep the vote open for Council Member Gjonaj and for at least 10 more minutes but I do understand that Council Member Barron has her hand raised for a question or a statement.

CHAIRPERSON DROMM: Council Member Barron? Council Member Barron, did you want to ask a question?

COUNCIL MEMBER BARRON: Yes, thank you so much.

Thank you to the Chair. It's not regarding — can you hear me?

COUNCIL MEMBER BARRON: Okay, it's not regarding the matters on the calendar. It is regarding

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however, a budget item and since BNT I don't believe is continuing to meet, I thought I would start here with finance.

It regards the money that my understanding was in the budget. That there would be \$20 million returned for the ASAP, along with \$14 million, which would be a total of \$34 million. Yesterday, it was said to me that there was an error or discrepancy recording this amount and that the 24 ASAP is not in fact in the budget.

So, I am raising this question now with Finance, hoping that I can get some clarity and some clear understanding. I was told that it was 54 that CUNY was requesting and not the 34. So, I would like some clarity. I know this is the first time that you are hearing about it. Council Member Dromm, I didn't get a chance to talk to you previously but I want someone to give me some clarity on the funding that is in fact in this budget for ASAP and how that money is designated.

I know you don't have an answer now but please.

CHAIRPERSON DROMM: Thank you Council Member

Barron. I don't know the answer right now but we
