CHAIRPERSON CHIN: Good morning. I am

Council member Margaret Chin, Chair of the Committee
on Aging. Today, I am joined by my colleague,

Council member Diaz, Vallone, Ayala, and Council
member Deutsch. Today, the Committee will vote on
proposed Intro 2030 which I am proud to sponsor.

Proposed Intro 2030 increases the maximum qualifying
income level for those who are applying to the senior
citizen rent increase exemption and that disability

rent increase exemption or SCRE/DCRE program. The
SCRE and DCRE programs also referred to as the New
York City Brent Freeze Program, provides important
exemption from all or part of certain rent increases
for senior citizens and persons with disabilities who
live in qualifying subsidized housing. State law
allows New York City to provide the SCRE/DCRE
programs locally and to decide on income eligibility
requirements. In March 2014, the state passed a law
city to increase the income threshold for the
SCRE/DCRE program to \$50,000 per household. In May
and July 2014, the city Council passed a local law
authorizing this increase for the SCRE and DCRE,
respectively. The 2014 income eligibility level
increase expiring this past June. New York State
reauthorized the increase in June of 2020, expanding
it through June 2022 and now the city must also do
the same. Intro 2030 extends these increased
qualifying levels to June 30th, 2022. I support this
important piece of legislation that helps keep our
seniors and disabled persons in affordable housing.
