I want to thank Chair Moya and Chair Adams for their work on our Zoning and Landmarks Subcommittees. Today we will vote on two applications referred out of the

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subcommittees, but before we begin, I would like to recognize the committee counsel to review the remote meeting procedures.

the 505 West 134th Street Cluster for property in

Council Member Levin's district in Manhattan. This

application was submitted by pursuant to Articles

2	16 of the General Municipal Law and Article XI of
3	the Private Housing Finance Law. HPD requests the
4	approval of the Urban Development Action Area
5	project, waiver of the designation requirements of
6	Section 197-c and 197-d of the Charter and an
7	exemption for real property taxes for three city-
8	owned five story residential buildings located at
9	505, 523, and 527 West 134th Street. This approval
10	will facilitate the preservation of 69 units of
11	affordable homeownership. We will also vote to
12	approve the modifications LU 689 and 690, the 110-
13	40 Saultell Avenue Rezoning relating to property in
14	Chair Moya's district in Queens. The application
15	seeks zoning map amendment to rezone an R6B zoning
16	district in R6, it's an R6 district as well as a
17	zoning text amendment to establish a Mandatory
18	Inclusionary Housing Area utilizing options 1 and
19	2. The proposals will facilitate the development
20	of a 6-story community facility and residential
21	building including approximately 25 dwelling units
22	and accessory parking. Our modification will
23	strike MIH Option 2 while retaining Option 1.
