A LOCAL LAW

To amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the tax on coin-operated amusement devices.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 15 of title 11 and section 11-4013 of the administrative code of the city of New York are REPEALED.

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
