Today the Committee will be voting on five items: an expense budget modification, a revenue budget modification, and transparency resolution and two Article XI Property Tax exemptions. Before the we begin, I would like to give a very warm welcome to our newest member of the Finance Committee Darma Diaz. I speak to you on behalf of the committee in stating that we look forward to working with you.

COUNCIL MEMBER DARMA DIAZ: Thank you.

CHAIR DROMM: You're very welcome and welcome. Thank you. Now, let's start with the budget modification. The Expense Budget

Modification represents movements of approximately \$1.7 billion of funding between and with city agencies reallocate appropriations in the city's Expense Budget. The Revenue Budget Modification recognizes \$616.7 million in new revenues in Fiscal 2021, which combined with an adjustment to the General Reserve will be used to pre-pay \$632.2 million in Fiscal 2022 expenses. Next we have the Transparency Resolution. the Transparency Resolution sets forth the new designation and changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving local, aging, anti-poverty and new

discretionary funding and funding pursuant to funding pursuant to certain initiatives in the budget. As with all transparency resolutions Council Members will have to sign a disclosure form indicating whether or not a conflict exists with any of the groups on the attached list. If any Council Member has a potential conflict of interest with any of the organizations listed, he or she has the opportunity to disclose the conflict at the time of their vote. As a reminder, please disclose any conflicts you may have with proposed subcontractors used by organizations sponsored by discretionary funding. These disclosures must be made before the subcontractor can be approved. Disclosure forms must be completed and submitted prior to vote on the Transparency Resolution and may be emailed to Charles Davis. Next, we have the two Land Use items. The first is Scheuer House of Brighton Beach in Council Member Deutsch's district. This action would provide a partial 40year Article XI Property Tax Exemption to support the preservation of 153 units of affordable rental housing. The second is Ridgewood, Bushwick 203-K in Council Member Reynoso and Diaz's districts.

This action would provide a full 40-year Article XI Property Tax Exemption to support the preservation of 83 units of affordable home ownership.
