CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: Thank you, ah, thank you, Sergeant at Arms. Ah, good morning. I am, ah, Council Member Rafael Salamanca. I'm the chair of this committee. Ah, I would like to, ah, welcome my colleagues who have joined us today. We have been joined by Chair Moya, ah, Council Member Adams, Grodenchik, Perkins, Rivera, Deutsch, Ayala, Barron, Borelli, Powers, Chair Riley, Treyger, Koo, ah, Council Member R. Diaz, Ruben Diaz, Sr., and

2 Vanessa Gibson. Today we will vote on several

3 applications referred on from our subcommittees. But

4 before we begin I would like to recognize the

CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: Ah, thank you,

Counsel. From our land, Landmarks Subcommittee,

today we'll vote to approve LU 711, an application

for the 110 Lenox Avenue ANCP cluster, submitted the

Department of Housing Preservation and Development.

In addition to the Urban Development Action Area

request and waiver of the requirements of Sections

197-C and 197-D of the charter. An Article 11 2 3 Private Housing Finance Law tax exemption is 4 requested for properties located at 110 Lenox Avenue, 128 West 116th Street, and 1971 7th Avenue in the Manhattan council district represented by Council 6 Member Perkins. Our [inaudible] will facilitate the renovation of four city-owned buildings for the 8 preservation of 55 affordable units of housing, including 37 cooperative home ownership units. 10 11 will also vote to approve preconsidered LU 717, the Landmarks Preservation Commission historic landmark 12 13 designation of the Angel Guardian Home located at 14 6301 12th Avenue in Dyker Heights section, borough of 15 Brooklyn, in Council Member Menchaca's district. Angel Guardian Home was built in 1899 as an orphanage 16 17 and was operated by the Sisters of Mercy as a branch 18 of their convent in Clinton Hill. It was, 19 designated by George H. Streeton, a prominent 20 architect of Catholic churches in New York City. 21 Angel Guardian Home's design was intended to express the importance of a social service mission. 2.2 2.3 building is a brick and limestone structure with details that [inaudible] European architecture. 24 grand civic scale and blend of style makes it stand 25

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| 3 | From our zoning subcommittee we will vote to approve |
| 4 | with modifications LU 712 and 713, the Cort Theatre |
| 5 | Rehabilitation Project, relating to a property in |
| 6 | Council Member Powers' district in Manhattan. The |
| 7 | application seeks a zoning text amendment and a |
| 8 | special permit for property and special midtown |
| 9 | district. Approval will facilitate the |
| LO | rehabilitation and expansion of the existing Cort |
| 11 | Theatre on West 48th Street. It would also |
| L2 | facilitate the development of a new hotel building on |
| L3 | the zoning lot, which would front on West 47th |
| L4 | Street. The proposed text amendment would modify the |
| L5 | theater rehabilitation provision for certain eligible |
| L6 | zoning lots to allow bonus floor area to be used |
| L7 | anywhere within the zoning, within such zoning lots. |
| L8 | And a special permit would facilitate a comprehensive |
| L9 | modernization of the Cort Theatre. The improvements |
| 20 | include a range of operational and accessibility |
| 21 | upgrades through the addition of a new structural |
| 22 | annex as well as interior preservation work |
| 23 | throughout the existing landmark theater. A |
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modification to zoning text would be to clarify and

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2 narrow the provision of the special permit. And with 3 that I will allow Council Member Powers for comments.

COUNCIL MEMBER POWERS: Thank you, Chair Salamanca, and good morning, everyone. Um, I want to say thank you for, to Chair Salamanca and also Chair Moya for their, ah, leadership and help with regard to the application we're discussing here and voting on today. Ah, the Cort Theatre in my district is, ah, planned to go under a rehabilitation and it's a project that since I've in the council they've been looking at and talking about, and today it's an opportunity to actually bring this for a vote and, ah, help out a Broadway theater at a time where Broadway's lights are off and they certainly need our help the most. This project would allow for to create an additional, ah, FAR bonus, ah, based on a, ah, a provision of the zoning resolution related to the theater district and to allow them to transfer those developmental rights in exchange for, ah, to allow for the rehabilitation of their theater. this project, as I noted, I, I think I first visited this theater three years ago, maybe it was four years ago at this point, right when I came into the council, and have been working on this project for

| 4 | for Broadway and part of our obligation to invest in |
| 5 | the Broadway and our tourism sector here in New York |

| 9 | to make sure that we got it, ah, to the finish line, |
| 10 | and I want to say thank you and congratulate the |
| 11 | folks at the Shubert organization for their work here |
| 12 | and how important this project is to them, and they |
| 13 | have worked diligently over the last few weeks to get |
| 14 | this project to the finish line, and so, um, I think |
| 15 | in just a matter of time we'll be able to turn the |
| 16 | lights back on on Broadway, but also be making here |
| 17 | today an investment in one of the important |
| 18 | organizations and the important theaters here in the |
| 19 | theater district. So thank you, I encourage you all |
| 20 | to vote aye, I'm very proud of where we are today on |
| 21 | this project and, ah, hope you all will support it. |
