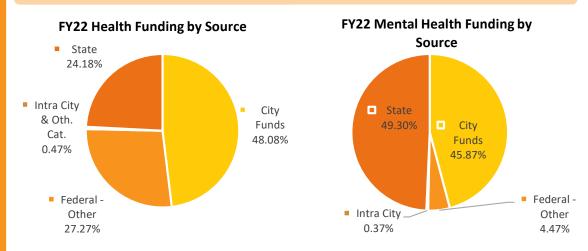


- \$2.96 million new needs to Learning Bridges Call Center

- \$2.9 million new needs for nurses in new community schools

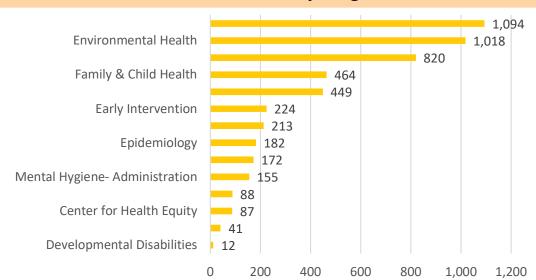


- \$2.3 million savings through hiring and attrition management

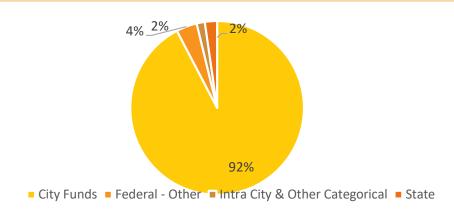

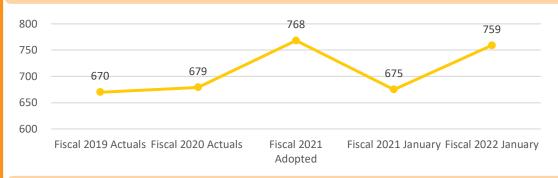
