COVID-19 Loan and Grants Program

- NYC Business Continuity Loan Fund. The total funding allocated to this loan program was \$22.9 million of which \$5 million was federal funding and the remainder was private funding.;
- **The NYC LMI Storefront Loan.** The total funding for this loan program is \$35 million of which \$4 million is federal funding and \$31 million is private capital;
- **The NYC Employee Retention Grant Program.** The total funding for this grant program was \$24.9 million, all of which was federal funding;
- The Interest Rate Reduction Grant. The total budget for this grant is \$2 million all of which is federal funds;
- The Strategic Impact COVID-19 Commercial District Support Grant. This is a City funded grant program for a total of \$750,000; and
- The NYC Small Business Emergency Grant Program. The total funding for this grant program is \$1.3 million all of which is private dollars.
