My name is Council Member James Sanders, 8 Jr., and I am the Chair of the Committee on Civil Service and Labor. Today we are having a second 9 10 hearing and voting on Proposed Intro 24-A. 11 bill captures an agreement between the Bloomberg Administration and the United Federation of 12 13 Teachers, UFT. It changes the vesting of health 14 benefits for UFT retirees from ten to 15 years, 15 but only applies to newly hired teachers. The 16 parties' agreement requires a change in the City 17 law to be effective. The bill does not change the vesting of health insurance benefits for any other 18 19 City retirees, which remains at ten years for most 20 City retirees. I want to acknowledge my wonderful Committee, and I want to thank him, thank 21 22 everyone, very much for, for doing the great work 23 that they have done.
