COUNCIL MEMBER MOYA: Moya is here.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And Council Member Moya.

Good Morning sir. This resolution at hand, encourages the state to authorize public employees to offer temporary retirement incentives to employees age 55 and older, who have served at least 25 years of service in the pension system. COVID-19 has thrust our city into a budget crisis and a \$5.25 billion deficit.

Early retirement would create additional savings without resorting to layoffs. It would allow dignified exit with full benefits and pension to veteran members of our public workforce, who are currently compensated at higher rates.

In turn, early retirement will allow the city to diversify its range with newer, younger employees that better represent the diversity of our new city. We have spoken before about the need to equally, to have equity in representation across all agencies. This means, this is a means of achieving that.

Also, the city has gone to the Municipal Labor
Council in the past and asked the Unions to find
savings in order to avoid layoffs, in order to avoid
service cuts, in order to avoid diminished benefits,
and this is one way of doing that. Aside from being
able to achieve a significant savings because the
older, the more veteran employees have a much richer
benefit package but it will allow us to move into the
future with a more diverse workforce.

So, I'm excited that Council Member Ampry-Samuel introduced this legislation and I have the opportunity to coprime as many of you have signed on as well. So, I'm not sure if Council Member Ampry-Samuel is available? Is she on?

MODERATOR: I don't believe she's on Chair.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay, I did say I was going to try to hold on for her but in that case, she will obviously speak this afternoon on the legislation.

And I will be voting aye in favor and Council Members of the Committee's do the same.

This is important piece of legislation for our public employees but also for the welfare and fiscal responsibilities of our city. So, with that, Mr. Clerk.
