4	My name is Domenic M. Recchia, Jr., and I am the
5	chairman of this wonderful committee. I'd like to
6	introduce all of my colleagues who are here today:
7	Annabel Palma, Oliver Koppell, Brad Lander, Karen
8	Koslowitz, Lew Fidler, Jimmy Oddo, Al Vann, Vinny
9	Ignizio, Julissa Ferreras, and Jimmy Van Bramer.
10	Today, we have six Land Use items
11	on our agenda, all of which provide property tax
12	exemptions to rental housing in various boroughs.
13	The first Land Use item is a property located at
14	11-114 Eldridge Street in Manhattan. This
15	property is located in Council Member Margaret
16	Chin's district. It would receive a property tax
17	exemption for the rehab of 16 units of rental
18	housing for low income families.
19	The second item is in Council
20	Member Chin's district. The property is located
21	at 28-30 Henry Street. It will receive a property
22	tax exemption for 36 units of rental housing for
23	low income families.
24	The third is in Council Member
25	Chin's district, located at 58-62 Hester Street.

2	It also will receive a property tax exemption for
3	rehab of 38 units of rental for low income
4	families. Council Member Chin supports all three.
5	We've been joined by Council Member
6	Leroy Comrie and Council Member Gale Brewer. The
7	fourth Land Use item is in Lafayette Manor, a
8	property located at 226 Fillmore Street in Staten
9	Island in Council Member Rose's district. This
10	property would also get an exemption for the
11	construction of 59 units of rental housing for the
12	elderly.
13	The fifth Land Use is Navy Green, a
14	mixed use development that would consist of
15	several properties located at 136-50 Flushing
16	Avenue in Brooklyn, Council Member Tish James'
17	district. This property tax exemption will be for
18	new construction of several buildings that will be
19	collectively known as Navy Green.
20	The sixth and final Land Use item
21	is the Council Towers VI Senior Housing
22	development in Council Member Jimmy Gennaro's
23	district. The property tax exemption would
24	provide for the new construction of 77 units in an
25	eight-story building for low income elderly

3	Anthony Brito from Council Finance
4	is available to answer any questions you may have
5	on these six Land Use items. I also want to
6	remind the committee that tomorrow, May 13th, will
7	be the start of the Executive Budget hearings.

9	begin at 11:15 tomorrow, not 10:00, to hear from
10	the Department of Finance followed by the
11	Department of Design and Construction followed by
12	DEP. I just want to give all of my colleagues
