Ah, this morning we are here to vote on Introduction number 1681-A, which would require the chancellor of the Department of Education to work with school sustainability coordinators to develop a plan for reducing food waste. This plan would be submitted to the Department of Sanitation for recommendations, as well as the Speaker of the City Council. The bill would require DOE to submit an annual report with information on DOE's actions to implement its food waste prevention plan and the chancellor's update to such plan. While DOE has made

2	great strides in recent to curb food waste and
3	implement strict purchasing guidelines through its
4	office of Food and Nutrition Services, it does, it
5	does not mean there is no waste. On any given day
6	the DOE services more than 800,000 meals. Any
7	further efforts to help eliminate food waste in an
8	environmentally friendly manner is an effort worth
9	taking. Ah, this is an important piece of
10	legislation, um, and I certainly look forward to, to
11	voting yes. I want to thank the committee staff,
12	Malcolm Buttehorn, Janette Well, our newest policy
13	analyst, welcome to the team, ah, ah, Aleah
14	Reynolds, Maycis Serkisian, ah, Chelsea Battermore,
15	Frank Perez, and my own staff, Anna Skaff, Vanessa
16	Ogle, Jeanine Teraketi, and Maria Henderson. Ah,
