The City Planning Commission (the "Commission") has received the attached correspondence, dated August 13, 2021, from the City Council regarding the proposed modifications to the above-referenced applications submitted by Brisa Builders Development LLC and God's Battalion of Prayer Properties, Inc. The modifications to the zoning map amendment and the zoning text amendment include a reduction of the rezoning boundary through the elimination of the nursing home site (Block 16041, Lot 6).

On August 11, 2021 the Land Use Committee of the City Council, by a vote of 11-0-0 for Applications C 200230 ZMQ and N 200231 ZRQ, recommended modifications of the City Planning Commission's decisions in the above-referenced matters.

The Zoning Resolution of the City of New York, effective as of December 15, 1961, and as subsequently amended, is hereby amended by changing the Zoning Map, Section No. 30c, by changing from an R4A District to an R6 District property bounded by a line 540 feet northerly of Beach Channel Drive, a line midway between Beach 66th Street and Beach 67th Street, a line 230 feet northerly of Beach Channel Drive, and Beach 67th Street, a line 100 feet northerly of Beach Channel Drive, and Beach 67th Street, Borough of Queens, Community District 14, as shown on a diagram (for illustrative purposes only) dated March 1, 2021, and subject to the conditions of CEQR Declaration E-605.


