CHAIRPERSON GENNARO: Protection. Today, we will hold about on proposed Intro 2283-A in relation to the reductions and reporting of greenhouse gas emissions at night show run facilities. Local law 97 voted into law almost 2 years ago now represents the largest single carbon reduction effort that any city has ever put forward. That is a big statement. It will result in the equivalent of taking more than 1 million cars off the road by 2030. It will also create tens of thousands of good jobs for the New Yorkers who need the most according to the multiple independent studies. people in this room know, local law 97 passed as part of a package of bills known as the Climate Mobilization Act. We chose this name because these bills merely represented the beginning and not the end of the city's response to the climate crisis. is up to all of us, public and private alike, to do our part to create a more sustainable city. Today will take an important stem to advance local law 97.
