Item number 20105514 TCM, Manhattan Community Board 12. Item number 119, Land Use number 119, another sidewalk café in the Speaker's District, calendar number 20105495 TCM, in Manhattan Community Board 12, Bar Pitti.

And an amendment to facilitate the development of a 13-story residential building in Council Member Koppell's district, Bronx Community Board 12, Land Use item number 120, calendar item number C 090143 ZMX on East Fordham Road.

We have also in the Speaker's district an amendment to the zoning text to ensure that future development reflects the existing neighborhood character within the Hudson Yards Garment Center, Community Board 4, item number N 1000217 ZRM. 16	Metropolitan Avenue, item number 20105402 SCQ.
17	We have another primary school in
18	Council Member Ferreras's district. It's going to
19	be called PS 287, located at 110-02 to 110-20
20	Northern Boulevard, a 380-seat primary school in
21	Community Board 3, 20105362 SCQ.
22	In Council Member Van Bramer's
23	District, he's getting an IS/High School, 1,100
24	seat intermediate Intermediate/High School, Land

Use number 126, in Queens Community Board 2, item

2 number 20105483 SCQ.

In the Speaker's District there is going to be another school in Manhattan Community Board 4. It's a PS 51 replacement. It's a new, 630-seat Primary/Intermediate School, located at 515-533 West 44th St., item number 20105713 SCM.

Land Use Item number 129, it's a school in Council Member Mendez's district, 850-seat Intermediate/High School, Manhattan Community Board 5, 20105590 SCM. It's going to be located at 10 E. 15th Street.

And we have another item, an HPD action to facilitate the rehabilitation of an affordable housing project. It's known as Mother Zion, in Council Member Dickens's district,
