SERGEANT AT ARMS: Check, check, one, two, one, two. This is a prerecorded sound check for the Committee on Women and Gender Equity. Today is October 21, 2021, being recorded by Michael Leonard and the committee.

CHAIR DARMA DIAZ: Good morning and welcome to today's Committee on Women and Gender (Inaudible) Council Member Helen Rosenthal. Equity. This will require Health and Social Services to review and report on services on individuals who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, questioning, intersex, non-confirming, and non-binary who are in domestic violence shelters including (inaudible). Domestic violence and intimate partner violence effects many people who identify as LGBTQI plus, but little is known about the services that city provides specifically for the population of survivors. The Bill will require the Administration to review and report on how it allows individuals who are entering DV shelters who selfidentify. What services, supports, and resources does it offer specifically to that population. Outreach efforts and any complaints the department

has received about DV shelter services provided to the LGBTQI plus residents. The Bill would also require DSS to ensure recommendations for enhancing its outreach efforts and services. Finally, the Bill will require DSS to work with a community-based organization to develop and provide culturally competitive training to DV shelter staff who directly work with residents who identify as LGTBQI plus. I would like to thank my staff, from the legislative division, Chloe Rivera (SP?), Bianca Ratell (SP?) for their work on this Bill. I will now turn it over to Council Member Rosenthal for her remarks on her legislation.
