A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the department of health and mental hygiene to provide license and permit expiration notifications electronically

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subchapter 1 of chapter 3 of title 17 of the administrative code of the city of New York is

amended by adding a new section 17-303 to read as follows:

§ 17-303 Electronic renewal notifications. For any applicant for or holder of a license or permit issued

by the department, the department shall, upon request, provide all notices relating to the expiration or renewal

of such license or permit electronically, in addition to any notices sent by regular mail. Electronic notices

relating to the renewal of any license or permit shall be sent at least 60 days before the date such license or

permit expires.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 120 days after it becomes law.
