Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Marchi, S.5745-A, and by Committee on Rules, A.8604-A, "AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to establishing a supplements fund for members of the New York fire department pension fund"; and
