**Whereas**, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Maltese, S.4081, and Assembly Member Perry, A.1445, "AN ACT to amend the New York city charter, the vehicle and traffic law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the environmental control board adjudication of disputes concerning the blocking of a driveway; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon thereof"; and

**Whereas**, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
