

Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 30 West 26th Street, Manhattan (20075236 TCM; L.U. No. 481).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on June 7, 2007 its approval of the petition dated June 7, 2007 of Hill Country New York, LLC, (the "Applicant"), for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 30 West 26th Street, Community District 5, Borough of Manhattan, (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Petition on July 23, 2007; and
