WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on July 7, 2000 its decision dated June 28, 2000 (the "Decision") on the application submitted pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter by the Department of Citywide Administrative Services, for the disposition of one (1) city-owned property pursuant to zoning, located at 5 Bay Street (Block 1/Lot 60), Borough of Staten Island (ULURP No. C 000381 PPR) (the "Application");

WHEREAS, the Application is related to ULURP Application number C 000380 ZMR (L.U. No. 712), an amendment to the Zoning Map;

WHEREAS, the Decision is subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Section 197-d(b)(3) of the City Charter;
