WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on June 8, 2005 its approval of the petition of YNLC Café Corporation, d/b/a Avenue Café (the "Applicant"), for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 35-27 30<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Community District 1, Borough of Queens (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Applicant indicated its intention to withdraw the Petition and by letter July 26, 2005 the applicant withdrew the Petition;
