A Local Law in relation to a street name, East 23rd Street/Delamere Place, Borough of Brooklyn.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
East 23 rd Street/ Delamere Place	East 23 rd Street	between Campus Road and Foster Avenue

§2. The new name shall be indicated on the city map and signs bearing the new name shall be erected in place of signs bearing the present name.

§3. This local law shall take effect immediately.

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
