WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on January 28, 2004 its approval of the petition of Sushi Mambo, Inc. for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk cafe located at 255 Bleecker Street, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;
