Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senators Velella, Golden, Maltese, Marchi, Mendez and Padavan, S.867, and Assembly Members Abbate and McLaughlin, A.3471, "AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to certain impairments of health presumed accidental or incurred in the performance of duty "; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
