WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on March 22, 2005, copy of its designation dated March 15, 2005 (the "Designation"), of the Offerman Building, located at 503-13 Fulton Street and 234-48 Duffield Street, Community District 2, Borough of Brooklyn, as a landmark and Block 145, Lot 35, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;
