WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on May 26, 2005 its decision dated May 25, 2005 (the "Decision") on the application submitted pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter by Lincoln Center Development Project, Inc., for a revocable consent to construct and maintain thirteen informational kiosks on the sidewalk of the south side of West 65<sup>th</sup> Street between Broadway and Amsterdam Avenue, Block 1134, Lots 1 and 25, Community District 7, Borough of Manhattan (ULURP No. C 050170 GFM) (the "Application");

WHEREAS, the Application is related to Applications Numbers N 050169 ZRM (L.U. No. 496), an amendment to the text of the Zoning Resolution; C 050098 MMM (L.U. No. 497), an amendment to the City Map; and C 050219 PQM (L.U. No. 499), an acquisition of several easements;

WHEREAS, the Decision is subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Section 197-d(b)(3) of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Decision and Application on

June 15, 2005;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the relevant environmental issues and the Negative Declaration issued on December 20, 2004 (CEQR No. 05DCP019M); and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Decision and Application;
