Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Velella, S.6950, and Committee on Rules, A.11031, "AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of the New York, in relation to establishing a variable supplements fund for sanitation members of the New York city employees' retirement system"; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
